

# 36 GO-FAST HATS TO CROCHET

What's up? The crochet hat, designed for us by Helen Bullett in three dozen snappy, snazzy, snugly versions. Most of them are composed of easy single crochet, double crochet and shells (a few start out with knitted ribbing), and each hat just takes an evening or two to complete. Ideal mini projects for beginners, they cost little (most use less than a dollar's worth of yarn) and if you make a mistake you don't have far to go to correct it. Whatever your level

of expertise, you'll want to get started now on hats for yourself (choose your own colors to match a favorite outfit) and for friends and family; it's never too soon to start thinking about Christmas presents. By the way, crocheting is catching, so be sure to keep an extra hook and some yarn around to satisfy the yearnings of eager onlookers (a teenage daughter, for instance). All of these hats are made of Coats & Clark's knitting worsted.

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
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

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein taupeed No. 356, 2 ounces each yellow No. 230 and tangerine No. 253; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**Gauge:** 4 puff sts and 4 ch-2 = 3"; 5 rnds = 3".

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein mid-orange No. 243; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

4th rd d 6 times more. **14th rnd:** Do as in text dc, dc in each of next 2 dc leaving last lp of each st on hook. **y o** hook and draw through all 3 lps on hook (1 dc decreased). Repeat from \* around (7/2 dc). **15th rnd** Repeat 4th rnd. **16th rnd:** Repeat 14th rnd (4/8 dc). **17th through 19th rnds:** Repeat 4th rnd 3 times more. **20th rnd:** Repeat 4th rnd to last st. **21st, 22nd rnds:** Repeat 4th rnd to last st, sc in each of next 3 sts, sl st in each of next 2 sts. Break off.


**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces each russet No. 282 and medium gold No. 6011 aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.  
**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2".

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Starting at top with rust, ch 2. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd** Ch 3, work 17 dc in ring (18 dc counting ch-3 as 1 dc), sl st in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in same place as last sl st, \* ch 5, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from \* around ending sl st in ch-1 (6 lps). Break or rust, attach cord. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in

in same lp, \* 3 dc in next ch-2 lp.  
Repeat from \* around, sl st in ch-3.  
Break off gold; attach rust. **18th rnd**  
Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 3 dc, long

**Gauge:** 4 ch sts = 1".

**Knitted Headband:** Starting at top edge with No. 8 needles, cast 80 sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1½". Bind off loosely in ribbing. Sew ends together to form ring. With crochet hook, sl st in first bound off st.

**Crocheted Section: 1st rnd:** (Ch next 3 sts, sc in next st) twice. \* ch 3, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st. Repeat from \*, ending sl st in

sl (26 sps). **2nd rnd.** Sl 1 to center of first sp, \* ch 4, sc in next sp. Repeat from \*. **around**, join with sl st to base of beginning chain. **3rd rnd.** \* Ch 5, sc in next sp. Repeat from \*. **around.** Continuing in this manner, work the following rnds with the following number of ch sts: **4th rnd**—ch 6, **5th rnd**—ch 7, **6th rnd**—ch 3, **7th rnd**—ch 7, **8th rnd**—ch 6, **9th rnd**—ch 5, **10th rnd**—ch 4, **11th rnd**—ch 3, **12th rnd**—ch 2, **13th rnd**—ch 1.

**14th rnd:** \* Sc in next ch-1 sp, Repeat from \* around. **15th rnd:** \* Skip next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around until 5 sts remain. Break off, leaving 12" end. Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull up and break off.

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein lt. coral No. 790, 2 ounces amethyst No. 588, afghan crochet hook size J (or Canadian afghan hook No. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ); knitting needles, 1 pair No. 8 (or English needles No. 5) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 4 bars = 1", 3 rnds = 1".  
**Knitted Headband:** Starting at lower edge with No. 8 needles and coral, cast on 80 sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1". Bind off loosely in ribbing.

**Crocheted Crown: 1st row.** Keeping all lps on hook, draw up a lp in each st across with crochet hook (B1 lps). For second half of row work as follows: Y o and draw through 1 lp on hook, \* y o and draw through next 2 lps on hook. Repeat from \* across. **2nd row:** Insert hook in front of second vertical "bar" and draw a lp through bar; keeping all lps on



hook, draw up a p in each across. Work second half of row before. Repeat 2nd row 7 more. Break off coral; attach thst. With amethyst, repeat row 5 times more. Break off thst; attach coral. With coral, repeat 2nd row twice more.

**To Shape Top: 1st dec row:** 6 sts; place hook under next 2 sts; draw lp through (1 st decreased). Repeat from \* across. **Work 2nd half of row as before.** **2nd dec row:** \* Work 5 sts, c 2. Repeat from \* across. **Work 3rd half of row as before.** **3rd dec row:** \* Work 4 sts, c 2. Repeat from \* across. **Work 4th half of row as before.** **4th dec row:** \* Work 3 sts, c 2. Repeat from \* across. **Work 5th half of row as before.** **5th dec row:** \* Work 2 sts, c 2. Repeat from \* across. **Work 6th half of row as before.** **6th dec row:** \* Work 1 st, c 2. Repeat from \* across. Break leaving 20" end to sew back to front.

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**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2", 2 rnds  
**Top of Beret:** Starting at c with coral, ch 8. Join with sl to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, (y o insert hook into ring, y o hook and pull lp through, y o hook and through 1 lp, y o hook and through 2 lps) twice, y o hook and draw through 3 lps (first pm made); ch 5, (y o hook, insert into ring, y o hook and pull through, y o hook and draw th 1 lp, y o hook and draw through lps) 3 times, y o hook and through 4 lps (another puff st in ch 2, \* work puff st, ch 5, worst, ch 2. Repeat from \* twice; in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Sl next ch-5 corner sp, work first st, ch 2 and puff st in same (first corner made); ch 2, work st, ch 2 and puff st in same in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, \* work st, ch 2 and puff st in next ch-2 sp, ch 2. Repeat fr around, sl st in top of ch-3. should measure 4" in diameter. **rnd:** Sl st to next corner sp, first corner, ch 2, 2 dc in ne





between inc's, until 12 rnds have been completed (112 dc). **13th rnd:** (Dc in each of next 13 dc, 2 dc in next dc) 7 times; dc in each of next 8 dc, sc in each of next 3 dc, sl st in each of last 3 dc. Break off.

**Under-brim:** With bisque, ch 80. Join with sl st to form ring, being careful not to twist sts. **1st rnd:** \* Dc in each of next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around (88 dc). Continue as for 10th through 13 rnds of upper brim (120 sts). Break off.

**Joining:** Hold outer edges of upper and under-brims together, wrong sides facing and matching increases, under-brim facing you. **1st rnd:** With purple, work 1 sc in each dc around, working through both lps and both thicknesses; ch 1, turn. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc around, join with sl st. Break off. Sew chain edge of under-brim to upper-brim.

**Flower:** With pink, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** (In next ch, work 1 sc, 1 dc and 1 sc) 4 times (4 petals). **2nd rnd:** Fold petals of last rnd forward and work in back of them as follows: (Ch 2, sl st in base of 2nd sc of next petal) 4 times (4 lps made across back of petals). **3rd rnd:** Continuing to work in back of petals, (work 4 dc and 1 sl st in next lp) 4 times (4 petals). Break off. Attach purple to last sl st. **4th rnd:** (Ch 3, sl st in base of next sl st) 4 times (4 lps made). **5th rnd:** (Work 8 dc and 1 sl st in next lp) 4 times (4 petals). **6th rnd:** Repeat 4th rnd. **7th rnd:** (Work 10 dc and 1 sl st in next lp) 4 times (4 petals). Break off. Fold back brim as shown in photo and sew flower in place, sewing through all thicknesses.

## HAT NO. 17

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein mid rose No. 758; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3".

With rose, work first through 6th rnds as for hat No. 34 (72 dc). Hat should measure 3½" from center. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, work 2 dc in same place as sl st (first shell made); ch 1, skip next 3 dc, \* work 3 dc in next dc (another shell made); ch 1,



skip next 3 dc. Repeat from \* around (18 shells); join. **8th rnd:** Sl st across to first ch-1 sp, ch 6, dc in same sp, \* skip shell, work dc, ch 3 and dc in next ch-1 sp. Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-6. **9th rnd:** Sl st in first ch-3 sp, ch 3, work 2 dc in same sp (first shell made); ch 1, \* work a shell of 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1. Repeat from \* around (18 shells); join. Repeat 8th and 9th rnds twice more, then repeat 8th rnd once more.

**Edging:** Work sc, dc, tr, dc and sc in each ch-3 sp around; join. Break off.

## HAT NO. 18

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 3 ounces dark olive No. 650, 1 ounce baby yellow No. 224; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 2 dc rnds = 1".

Starting at top with olive, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, work 11 dc in ring (12 dc, counting ch-3 as 1 dc); join with sl st in top of ch-3. Break off olive; attach yellow. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, work 2 dc in same place as sl st, drop lp from hook, insert hook in top of ch-3, pick up dropped lp and pull through, ch 1 tightly (first popcorn made); ch 2, \* work 3 dc in back lp of next dc, drop lp from hook, insert hook in first dc, pick up dropped lp and pull through, ch 1 tightly (popcorn made); ch 2. Repeat from \* around (12 popcorns); join to first popcorn. Break off yellow; attach olive. **3rd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st, sc in next ch-2 sp, work long dc as follows: Y o hook, insert hook in back lp of same st on

first rnd where last popcorn was worked, pull lp through, (y o hook and pull through 2 lps) twice; sc in same sp, \* sc in top of next popcorn, work sc, long dc, and sc over next ch-2 sp. Repeat from \* around (48 sts); join with sl st in ch-1 sp.



**4th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each st around; join. Break off olive; attach yellow. **5th rnd:** Working in back lp only, work first popcorn, ch 2, skip next sc, \* work popcorn in next sc, ch 2, skip next 2 sc. Repeat from \* around (16 popcorns); join. Break off yellow; attach olive. **6th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st, sc in next ch-2 sp, work long dc over ch-2 in back lp at each skipped sc on 4th rnd, sc in same sp, \* sc in top of next popcorn, sc in next ch-2 sp, work long dc over ch-2 in back lp of each of 2 skipped sc on 4th rnd, sc in same sp. Repeat from \* around (80 sts); join. Piece should measure 5½" in diameter. **7th rnd:** Repeat 4th rnd. **8th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in next sc and in each sc around (80 dc); join. **9th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join. Repeat 9th rnd 4 times more. **13th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in back lp of next dc, dec 1 dc as follows: dc in back lp of each of next 2 dc leaving last lp of each st on hook, y o hook and draw through all 3 lps on hook, \* dc in back lp of each of next 2 dc, dec 1 dc. Repeat from \* around (60 dc); join. Break off olive; attach yellow. **14th rnd:** Repeat 5th rnd (20 popcorns). **15th rnd:** Repeat 6th rnd. Break off.

## HAT NO. 19

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces beige No. 328 and 1 ounce tangerine No. 253; aluminum crochet hook size J (or

Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3".

With beige only, work first through 6th rnds as for Hat No. 34 (72 dc). Hat should measure 3½" from center. Break off beige, attach tangerine. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, work dc, ch 1 and 2 dc in same place as sl st, ch 5, skip next 5 dc, \* work 2 dc, ch 1 and 2 dc in next dc, ch 5, skip next 5 dc. Repeat from \* around, sl st in top of ch-3. **8th rnd:** Sl st in next dc and ch-1 sp, ch 3, work dc, ch 1 and 2 dc in same sp, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of next ch-5, ch 2, \* work 2 dc, ch 1 and 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2, \* work 2 dc, ch 1 and 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2. Repeat from \* around, sl st in first sl st. **11th rnd:** Ch 3, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, \* dc in next sc, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, \* dc in next sc, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off beige, attach tangerine. Repeat 7th through 10th rnds once.



**Edging:** Ch 3, work 3 dc in same place as sl st, sc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp, \* work 4 dc in next sc, sc in 3rd ch of next ch-5 sp. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.

## HAT NO. 20

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 3 ounces lt. coral No. 790; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size



## HAT NO. 26

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces each light blue No. 809 and emerald green No. 676; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge; knitting needles, 1 pair No. 8 (for English needles No. 5).



**GAUGE:** 7 tr = 2"; 4 rnds = 3".

Starting at lower edge with No. 8 needles and blue, cast on 80 sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1". Bind off loosely in ribbing. Sew ends together to form ring. **Note:** Work in back lps only throughout. **1st rnd:** With crochet hook and blue, attach yarn to any bound-off st, ch 4, tr in each tr around, join with sl st to top of ch-4 (80 sts). **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, tr in each tr around; join. Repeat 2nd rnd once more. Break off blue; attach green. With green, repeat 2nd rnd once more. Break off green; attach blue. With blue, repeat 2nd rnd. Break off blue; attach green. With green, repeat 2nd rnd. Break off green; attach blue. **7th rnd:** Ch 4, tr in next tr; y o hook twice, draw up a lp in next st (4 lps on hook), y o, draw through 2 lps on hook, y o, draw up a lp in next st, y o, draw through 2 lps on hook, y o, draw through 3 lps on hook, y o, draw through remaining 2 lps on hook (1 tr decreased), \* tr in each of next 2 tr, dec 1 tr. Repeat from \* around (60 tr); join. **8th rnd:** Ch 4, dec 1 tr, \* tr in next tr, dec 1 tr. Repeat from \* around (40 tr); join. **9th rnd:** Ch 4, tr in next tr, \* dec 1 tr. Repeat from \* around (19 tr); join. **10th rnd:** Ch 4, \* dec 1 tr. Repeat from \* around (10 tr); join. **11th rnd:** Ch 1, \* draw up a lp in each of next 2 sts, y o hook and draw through all 3 lps on

hook. Repeat from \* around to last tr, sc in last tr; join. Break off, leaving 12" end. Thread end in tapestry needle, weave through remaining sts, pull tight and break off.

## HAT NO. 27

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces deep rose No. 759; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 4 ch sts = 1"; 2 rnds = 1".

Starting at top, ch 3. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, work 11 dc in ring (12 dc, counting ch-3 as 1 dc), sl st in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, \* dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-4 (12 sp). **3rd rnd:** Ch 6, \* dc in next dc, ch 3. Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-6 (12 sp). Piece should measure 3½" in diameter. **4th rnd:** Ch 8, \* dc in next dc, ch 5. Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-8. **5th rnd:** Ch 10, \* dc in next dc, ch 7.



Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-10. **6th rnd:** Ch 12, \* dc in next dc, ch 9. Repeat from \* around, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-12. Repeat 6th rnd 3 times more, 5th rnd twice. **12th rnd:** \* In next sp work sc, dc, tr, dc and sc; sc in next dc. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.

## HAT NO. 28

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein rust No. 282, 1 ounce paddy green No. 686; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**Top of Beret:** Starting at center

with rust, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, work 23 dc in ring (24 dc, counting ch-3 as 1 dc), sl st in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Ch 5, dc in same place as sl st, ch 1, skip 2 dc, \* work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc. Repeat from \* 6 times more; sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 3, dc, ch 2 and 2 dc in same sp, sc in next ch-1 sp, \* 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp. Repeat from \* around, sl st in top of ch-3. Piece should measure 4" in diameter. **4th rnd:** Sl st in next dc and in next ch-2 sp, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1 and 3 dc in same sp, sc in next sc, \* 3 dc, ch 1 and 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around, sl st in top of ch-3. **5th rnd:** Sl st in next dc, ch 5, dc in same st, ch 1, \* work dc, ch 2 and dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (work dc, ch 2 and dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, ch 1) twice. Repeat from \* 6 times more; work dc, ch 2 and dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, work dc, ch 2 and dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, ch 1, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5. **6th rnd:** \*



Sc in next ch-2 sp, work 4 dc, ch 1 and 4 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp. Repeat from \* around; sl st in sc. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, \* skip next sc and dc, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc, ch 2, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc, skip next dc and sc, dc in next sc. Repeat from \* around, omitting last dc on last repeat; sl st in top of ch-3. **8th rnd:** Ch 3, \* work dc in next ch-2 sp, work 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, work 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, work 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, omitting last dc on last repeat; sl st in top of ch-3. **9th rnd:** Ch 3, \* skip next dc,

work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc, skip next 2 dc, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next ch-2 sp, (skip next 2 dc, work dc, ch 2 and dc in next dc) twice; skip next dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, omitting last dc on last repeat; sl st in top of ch-3. **10th rnd:** Ch 3, \* (3 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc between next 2 dc) twice; work 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, (dc between next 2 dc, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) twice; skip next dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, omitting last dc on last repeat; sl st in top of ch-3. Break off.

**Bottom of Beret:** Starting at lower edge above headband, with rust ch 72 to measure about 20". Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 5, dc in same place as sl st, ch 1, skip 2 ch, \* work dc, ch 2 and dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 2 ch. Repeat from \* around; sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5 (24 V-sts). **2nd through 6th rnds:** Work as for 6th through 10th rnds of top of beret. Break off.

**Joining:** With wrong sides of top and bottom together and with right sides of top facing you and corners matching, work through both thicknesses as follows: Attach green to any corner sp, \* work 2 sc in corner sp, sc in each st to next corner. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.

**Headband:** Attach green to any ch along lower edge. **1st rnd:** Ch 1, work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp and 1 sc in base of each V-st around (72 sc); sl st in ch-1. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; sl st in ch-1. Repeat 2nd rnd twice more. Break off.

## HAT NO. 29


**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein lavender No. 584, 1 ounce bright pink No. 741; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 2 V-sts = 1½"; 2 rnds = 1".

**Flower Border:** With pink, ch 62. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \* skip 2 ch, work 5 dc in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from \* across. **2nd row:** Working along other side of chain, sc in first ch, \* skip 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from \* across. Join ends with sl st

to form ring (10 flowers made). Break off pink.

**Crown:** With lavender, sl st in joining sl st. **1st rnd:** Ch 5, sc in center dc of 5-dc group, ch 2, dc in next sc between flowers on opposite side of border, drawing up first lp 1½" long (long dc made). \* ch 2, sc in center dc of 5-dc group, ch 2, long dc in next sc. Repeat from \*




around; join. **13th rnd:** Sl st in sp between ch-3 and next dc, ch 3, dc in sp between next dc, dec 1 dc in sp between each of next 2 dc, \* dec 1 dc in sp between each of next 2 dc, repeat from \* around (21 dc); join. **14th rnd:** Sl st in sp between ch-3 and next dc, ch 3, y o hook, draw up a lp between next 2 dc, (y o, draw through 2 lps on hook) twice; \* dc in sp between next 2 dc, dec 1 dc in sp between each of next 2 dc. Repeat from \* around (14 dc); join. **15th rnd:** Repeat 12th rnd. **16th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp between next 2 dc, \* dec 1 dc in sp between each of next 2 dc. Repeat from \* around (7 dc, not counting ch-3 as 1 dc); join. Break off, leaving 12" end. Thread end in tapestry needle, run through remaining sts, pull tight and break off.

## HAT NO. 30

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces each mauve No. 754 and amethyst No. 588, 1 ounce mint julep No. 669; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6); or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3". With mauve, work first through 6th rnds as for hat No. 34 (72 dc). Hat should measure 3½" from center. Break off mauve; attach mint. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc; y o hook, insert hook in dc in row below last dc worked and draw up a ¾"-long lp, (y o hook and draw through 2 lps on hook) twice (long dc made); \* dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, work long dc. Repeat from \* around (108 dc); join. **8th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join. Break off mint; attach amethyst.



**9th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 dc, work long dc, \* skip next dc, dc in each of next 5 dc, work long dc. Repeat from \* around, skip last dc (108 dc); join. Repeat 8th rnd 4 times. **14th through 20th rnds:** Working as for hat No. 34, repeat 14th through 20th rnds.

## HAT NO. 31

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 3 ounces Nile green No. 679; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3". With green only, work first through 6th rnds as for hat No. 34 (72 dc). **7th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around; join. Repeat last rnd until hat measures 7½" from center.



**Enging:** Ch 3, work 4 dc in same place as sl st, drop lp from hook, insert hook in top of ch-3, pick up dropped lp and pull through st, ch 1 tightly (first popcorn made). \* skip 3 dc, work a shell of 7 tr in next dc, skip 3 dc, work 5 dc in next dc, drop lp from hook, insert hook in top of first dc, pick up dropped lp and pull through dc, ch 1 tightly (another popcorn made). Repeat from \* around, ending skip 3 dc, shell in next dc, skip 3 dc, sl st in top of first popcorn. Break off.

## HAT NO. 32

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein each apricot No. 433 and sea tones No. 432; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge; knitting needles, 1 pair No. 8 (or English needles No. 5).



**GAUGE:** 4 puff sts and 3 ch-2 = 4"; 4 rnds = 3".

**Top of Beret:** Starting at center with crochet hook and apricot, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, (y o hook, insert hook into ring, y o hook and pull lp through, y o hook and draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times; y o hook and draw through all 4 lps (first puff st made), ch 2, \* (y o hook, insert hook into ring, y o hook and pull lp through, y o hook and pull through 2 lps) 4 times; y o hook and pull through all 5 lps on hook (puff st made), ch 2. Repeat from \* 4 times more; sl st in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, work first puff st in same sp, ch 2, (first corner made); \* work puff st in next sp, ch 2, work puff st in same sp, ch 2 (another corner made). Repeat from \* around; join. Piece should measure 3½" in diameter. **3rd rnd:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, work first corner in same sp, work puff st in next sp, ch 2, \* work corner in next sp, work puff st in next st, ch 2. Repeat from \* around; join. **4th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, work first corner, (work puff st in next sp, ch 2) twice; \* work corner in next sp, (work puff st in next sp, ch 2) twice. Repeat from \* around; join. Continuing in same manner, working corners over corners, 1 more puff st in next sp and ch-2 between corners on each rnd. Work 2 more rnds apricot and 1 blue. Break off.

**Bottom of Beret: Knitted Headband:** Starting at lower edge with No. 8 needles and apricot, cast on 72 sts. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1". Bind off loosely in ribbing. Sew ends together to form ring.

**Crocheted Section 1st rnd:** With crochet hook and blue, sl st in first bound-off st, \* ch 3, skip 3 sts, sc in next st. Repeat from \* around (18

sts); sl st in sl st. **2nd rnd:** \* Work first puff st in next sp, ch 2, work puff st in same sp, ch 2 (corner made); (work puff st, ch 2 in next sp) twice. Repeat from \* around; join (24 puff sts—6 corners). Continuing in same manner as for top of hat, work 3 more rnds. Break off.

**Joining:** With wrong sides of top and bottom together and with right side of top facing you and corners matching, work through both thicknesses as follows: Attach blue to any corner sp, work first corner, (work puff st in next sp, ch 2) 6 times; \* work corner in next sp, (work puff st in next sp, ch 2) 6 times. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.

## HAT NO. 33



**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 1 (4-oz.) skein flame gold No. 602, 1 ounce each sea tones No. 909, cobalt blue No. 850; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 3 dc and ch-2 = 1"; 5 rnds = 3".

Starting at center, ch 4, join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, work 2 dc in ring, \* ch 2, 3 dc in ring (3-dc shell made). Repeat from \* twice more; ch 2, join with sl st to top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next 2 dc and in next ch-2 sp; ch 3, in same sp work 2 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc (first corner); \* ch 2, in next ch-2 sp work 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc (another corner). Repeat from \* twice more; ch 2, join. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next 2 dc and in next ch-2 sp, work first corner in same sp, \* ch 2, 3 dc shell in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, work corner in next corner sp. Repeat from \* twice more; ch 2, shell in next sp, ch 2, join. Piece should measure 4" in diameter. **4th rnd:**

Sl st in next 2 dc and in next sp, work first corner in same (ch 2, shell in next ch-2 sp) t ch 2, work corner in next corner. Repeat from \* twice more; (shell in next sp) twice; ch 2, join. **5th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 dc and next ch-2 sp, work first corner in same sp, \* ch 2, work shell in ch-2 sp. Repeat from \* to corner, ch 2, work corner in corner sp. Continue in pattern. Repeat last rnd twice more. **8th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 dc and in next sp, ch 3, work 2 dc in same sp, \* work shell in next ch-2 sp, Repeat from \* around (28 sts). **13th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 dc and next ch-2 sp, ch 3, work 2 dc in same sp leaving last lp of ea on hook, y o hook and draw th all 3 lps (1 dc dec), ch 1, \* continuing in pattern, in next ch-2 dc and dec 1 dc, ch 1. R from \* around; join. **14th rnd:** in next dc and in next ch-1 sp, dec 1 dc in same sp, \* dc around; join. **15th rnd:** Ch 3, each st around (56 dc, counting as 1 dc); join. Repeat last rnd more, crocheting more tightly each rnd. Break off.

## HAT NO. 34

**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, small amount gold No. 602, 1 ounce each sea tones No. 909, cobalt blue No. 850; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3". Starting at top with gold, c Join with sl st to form ring. **1st**



Ch 3, work 11 dc in ring (12 dc, counting ch-3 as 1 dc), join with sl st in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in base of ch-3, work 2 dc in each dc around (24 dc); join. **3rd rnd:** Repeat 2nd rnd (48 dc). Break off gold; attach scarlet. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around (48 dc); join. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, \* 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from \* to last dc, 2 dc in last dc (72 dc); join. Hat should measure 6" across. **6th rnd:** Repeat 4th rnd (72 dc). Break off scarlet; attach blue. **7th rnd:** Repeat 5th rnd (108 dc). Repeat 4th rnd twice. Break off blue; attach black. Repeat 4th rnd 3 times more. Break off black; attach white. Repeat 4th rnd once more. **14th rnd (dec rnd):** Ch 3; \* dc in each of next 2 dc leaving last lp of each st on hook, y o hook and draw through all 3 lps on hook (1 dc dec); dc in next dc. Repeat from \* to last 2 sts, dec 1 dc (72 dc); join. Repeat 4th rnd once more. **16th rnd:** Repeat 14th rnd (48 dc). Repeat 4th rnd 4 times more. Break off.

### HAT NO. 35



**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 2 ounces bright pink No. 741; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 rnds = 3".

With pink only, work first through 6th rnds as for hat No. 34 (72 dc). Hat should measure 3½" from center. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in next st, dc in st before ch-3 (this is last dc of last rnd—first criss-cross made); \* skip next st of last round, dc in each of next 2 st, dc in skipped st (criss-cross made). Repeat from \* around;

join with sl st in top of ch-3. **8th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; sl st in ch-1. **9th rnd:** Sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in next st, dc in st before ch-3 (first criss-cross made); \* work criss-cross over next 3 sts. Repeat from \* around; join. Repeat 8th and 9th rnds 3 times more.

**Edging:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in sp between next 2 dc, ch 3, sl st in same sp. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.

### HAT NO. 36



**MATERIALS:** Coats & Clark's knitting worsted, 3 ounces geranium No. 912; aluminum crochet hook size J (or Canadian hook No. 6) or the size that will give you the correct gauge.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 2"; 5 dc rnds = 3".

With geranium only, work first through 6th rnds as for hat No. 34 (72 dc). Hat should measure 3½" from center. **7th rnd:** \* Ch 3, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from \* around. **8th rnd:** Sl st in first ch-3 lp, \* work a shell of 2 dc, 4 tr and 2 dc in next lp, sc in next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times. Repeat from \* around, working last sc of last repeat in first sl st. **9th rnd:** Sl st across to first tr of first shell, \* ch 3, skip 2 tr, sc in next tr of same shell, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times; ch 3, sc in first tr of next shell. Repeat from \* around. **10th rnd:** Sl st in first ch-3 lp, ch 3, work 1 dc, 4 tr and 2 dc in same lp as sl st, sc in next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times; \* work 2 dc, 4 tr and 2 dc in next lp, sc in next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times. Repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of ch-3. Repeat 9th and 10th rnds 3 times more. **17th rnd:** \* Sc in each st of shell, sc in next sc, (2 sc in next lp, sc in next sc) 4 times. Repeat from \* around; join. Break off.
