What's up? The crochet hat, designed for us by Helen Bullett in three dozen snappy, snazzy, snugly versions. Most of them are composed of easy single crochet, double crochet and shells (a few start out with knitted ribbing), and each hat just takes an evening or two to complete. Ideal mini projects for beginners, they cost little (most use less than a dollar's worth of yarn) and if you make a mistake you don't have far to go to correct it. Whatever your level


of expertise, you'll want to get started now on hats for yourself (choose your own colors to match a favorite outfit) and for friends and family; it's never too soon to start thinking about Christmas presents. By the way, crocheting is catching, so be sure to keep an extra hook and some yarn around to satisfy the yearnings of eager onlookers (a teenage daughter, for instance).
